

The Perth Royal Infirmary (PRI) site experiences significant demand for car parking, which can lead to delays. Patients and visitors needing to travel by car to PRI are urged to leave enough time before their appointment so they can park their cars.

Patients and visitors are able to park in designated 'Patient and Visitor' car parks. Car parking is subject to time limits. There are 3 hour and 9 hour stay car parks. A free of charge ticket obtained from ticket machines must be prominently displayed on the windscreen of your vehicle.

Most 'Patient and Visitor' car parks are accessed via the Jeanfied Road entrance to PRI. A 3 hour limit car park is also located immediately in front of the Taymount Terrace entrance of PRI.

Please ensure that you observe parking terms and conditions which are stated on notices in each car park.

There are however several public transport options:

Service 444

Smith & Sons operate an off-peak weekday shuttle between Broxden (Park+Ride site) and PRI (bus turning circle). Running every half hour, between 0935 and 1515, this bus service offers a quick and easy means of accessing the hospital. The single fare is 80p, with a day return costing £1.00. National Entitlement Card holders travel free.

From the City Centre ...

There are good public transport services to Perth city centre from across the city and outlying areas, and these can be combined with Stagecoach Perth services 1 and 2 to reach PRI.

Services 1 and 2 provide a direct link between the city centre (Mill Street) and the hospital bus stops (on Western Avenue). Weekdays they operate a combined 5 minute daytime timetable, with lower frequencies in the evenings and at weekends.

In addition, Service 333 *hospital link* runs between Ninewells Hospital, Dundee and PRI offering a direct bus connection between the two hospitals.
